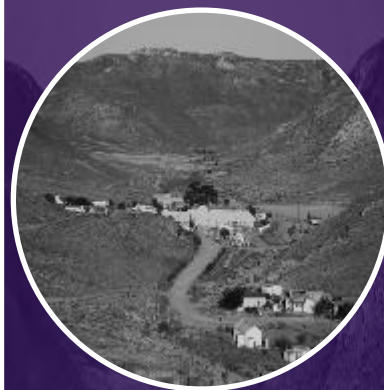

# INTRODUCTION

EARLY 2020

- 
- **Impact and pressure of Covid-19 pandemic on vulnerable households, farmers in remote areas.**
  - **Restricted access to markets dealt a heavy blow to farmers and their livelihoods!**
  - **Increased food insecurity.**



LOCK DOWN 2020

LAUNCH OF PESI

- **Launch of the Presidential employment stimulus packages (PESI).**
- **To support subsistence producers to retain self-employment and support food value chains.**



ROLLOUT

- **Subsistence producers in rural and peri-urban areas**
- **50% women, 40% youth, 5% military veterans and 5% people with disabilities were be targeted.**

DALRRD undertook a programme to support small scale farmers!

The process was manual and there was no system help with the verification of applications!



3

The manual process presented a number of challenges, more especially during the lockdowns where the forms could not be distributed nor collected and applicants were left destitute.

The PESI Task team developed a systematic approach, which served two critical purposes; 1. application of farmers (using Vodacom USSD code) and 2. verification of applicant farmers (using Survey 123).

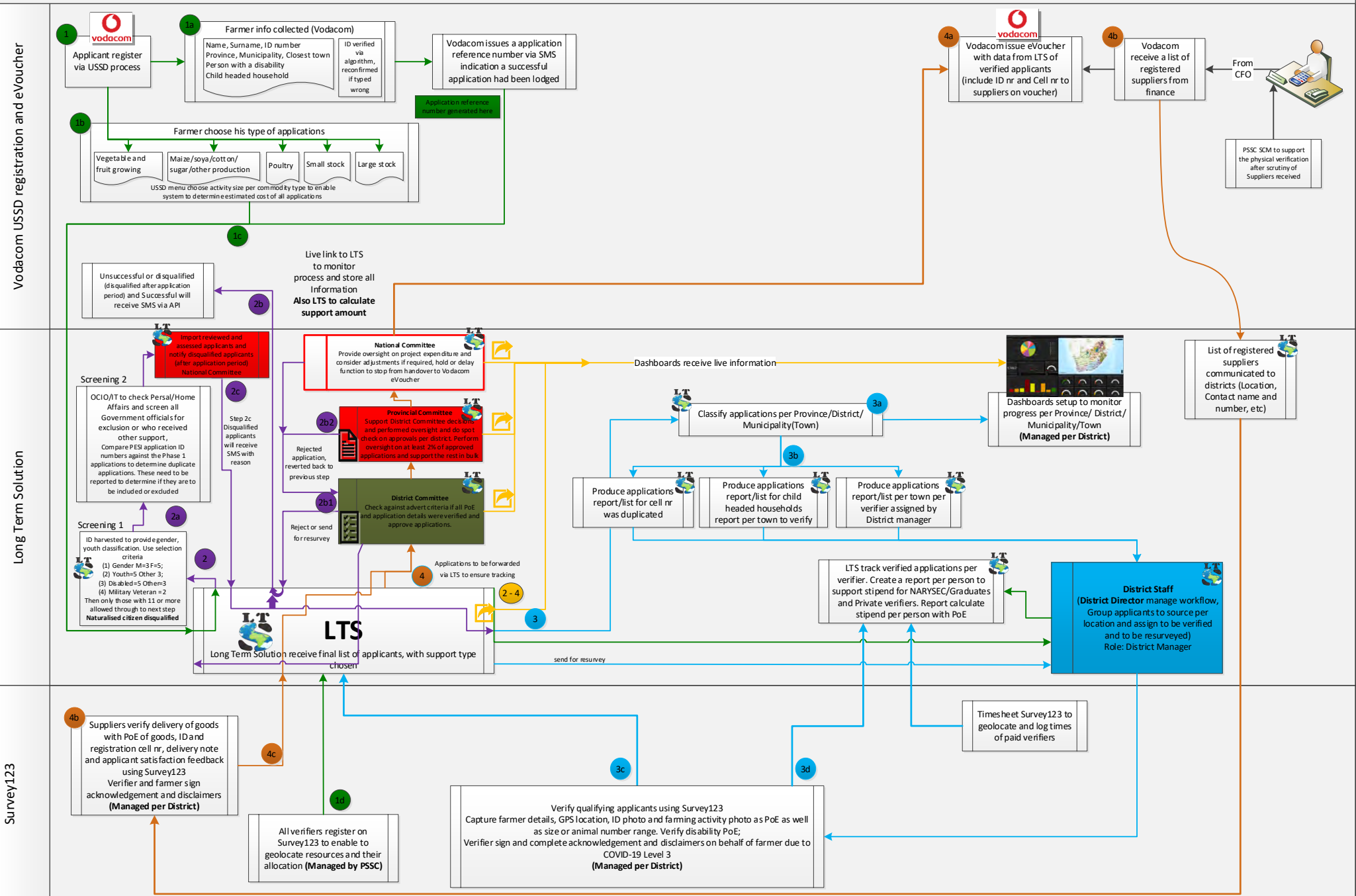

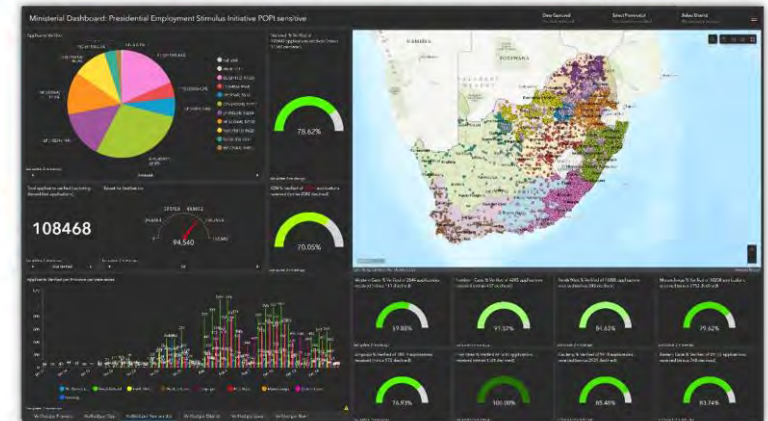

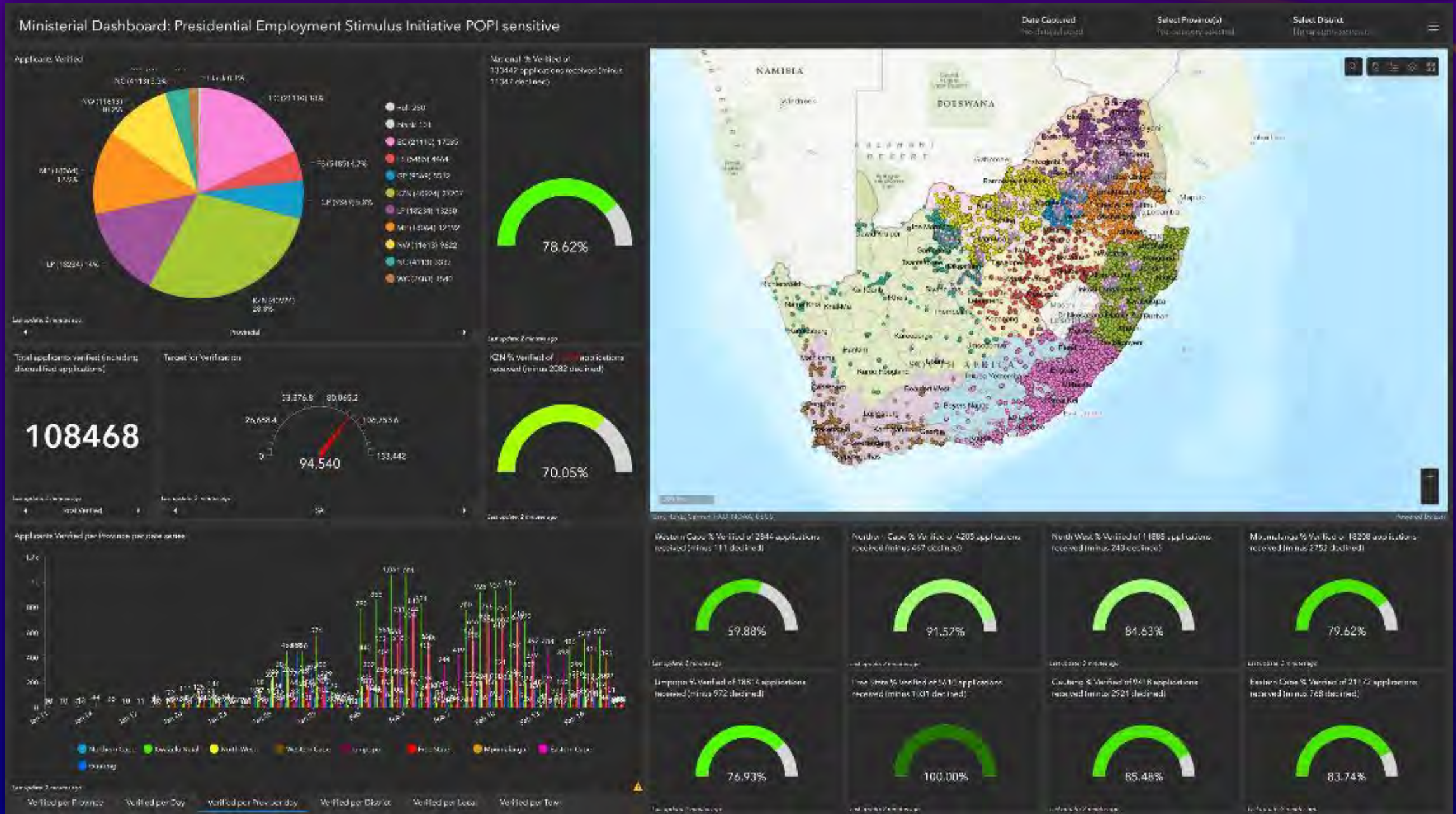
## Real-time data and stats through dashboards!

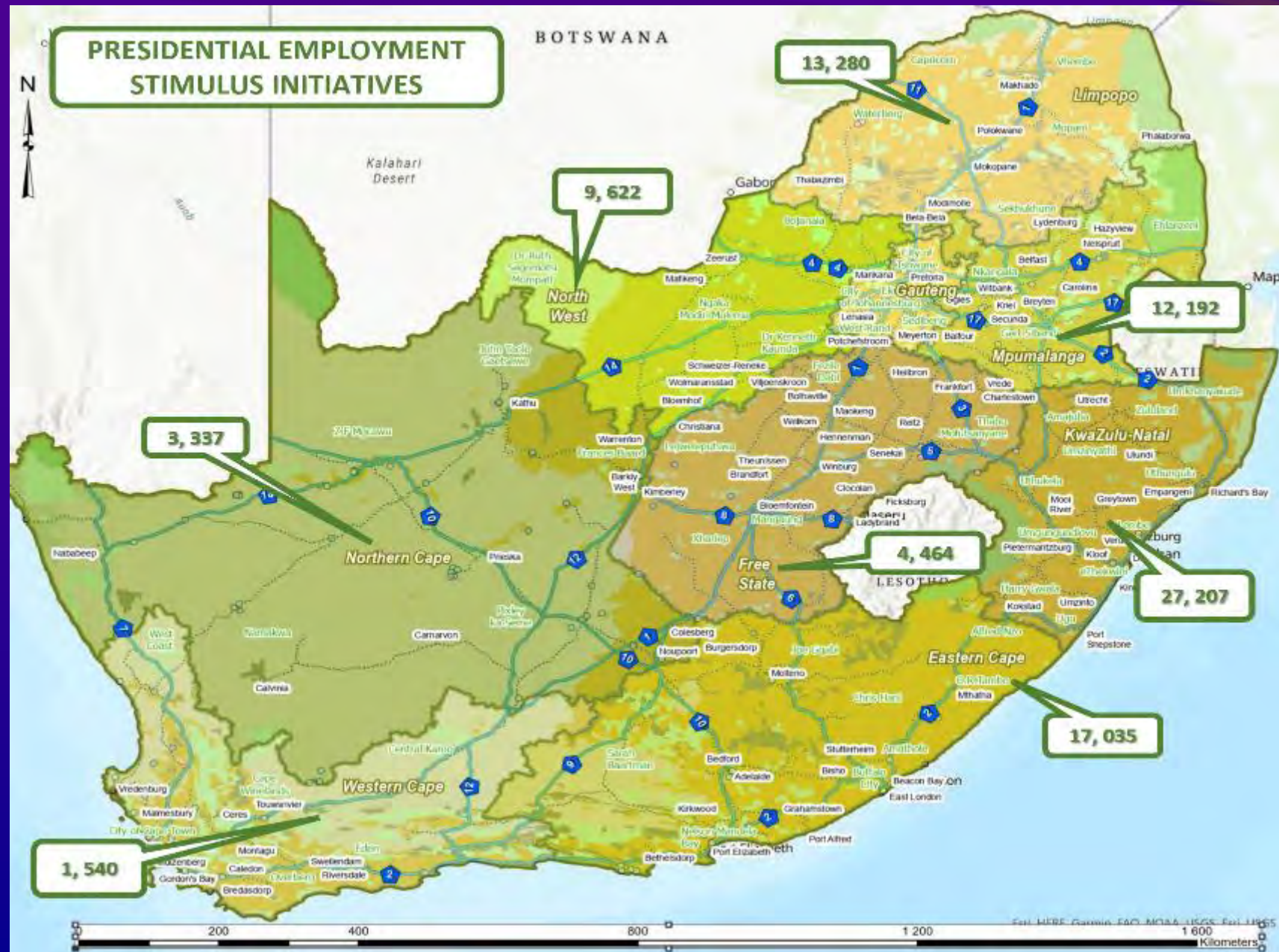
